

EXAMPLE OF ANALYSIS

PAKISTAN CODE OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE, 1898

22. Appointment of Justices of the Peace.

The Provincial Government may, by notification in the official Gazette, appoint for such period as may be specified in the notification, and subject to such rules as may be made by it any person who is a citizen of Pakistan and as to whose integrity and suitability it is satisfied, to be a Justice of the Peace for a local area to be specified in the notification, and more than one Justice of the Peace may be appointed for the same local area.

RE-WRITING OF SECTION 22 WITH FINITE VERBS

The Provincial Government may, by notification in the official Gazette, appoint for such period

As may be specified in the notification

And, which is Subject to such rules

As may be made by it any person

Who is a citizen of Pakistan

And, as to whose integrity and suitability it is satisfied,

To be a Justice of the Peace for a local area

To be specified in the notification,

And, more than one Justice of the Peace, may be appointed for the same local area.

SENTENCE ANALYSIS OF SECTION 22

MODIFIERS IN SECTION: Noun, Verb, Prepositional and Infinitive phrases

CLAUSES IN SECTION: There are nine clauses

1. The Provincial Government may, by notification in the official Gazette, appoint for such period (*Independent clause*)
2. As may be specified in the notification (*Subordinate clause*)
3. And, which is Subject to such rules (*Independent clause*)
4. As may be made by it any person (*Subordinate clause*)
5. Who is a citizen of Pakistan (*Subordinate clause*)
6. And, as to whose integrity and suitability it is satisfied (*Independent clause*)
7. To be a Justice of the Peace for a local area (*Subordinate infinitive clause*)
8. To be specified in the notification (*Subordinate infinitive clause*)
9. And, more than one Justice of the Peace, may be appointed for the same local area (*Independent clause*)

CLASSIFICATION OF SENTENCE: It is a compound-complex-sentence with four independent clauses and five subordinate clauses
