

## EXAMPLE OF ANALYSIS

### **BANGLA DESH CODE OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE, 1898**

#### **35. Sentence in cases of conviction of several offences at one trial**

##### **Maximum term of punishment:**

(1) When a person is convicted at one trial of two or more offences, the Court may, subject to the provisions of section 71 of the [Penal Code](#) sentence him, for such offences, to the several punishments prescribed therefor which such Court is competent to inflict; such punishments, when consisting of imprisonment or transportation to commence the one after the expiration of the other in such order as the Court may direct, unless the Court directs that such punishments shall run concurrently.

#### **RE-WRITING OF SUB-SECTION (1) OF SECTION 35 WITH FINITE VERBS**

When a person is convicted at one trial of two or more offences,

The Court may, subject to the provisions of section 71 of the [Penal Code](#) , sentence him, for such offences, to the several punishments

Which are prescribed therefor

Which such Court is competent

To inflict; such punishments

When consisting of imprisonment or transportation

To commence the one after the expiration of the other in such order

As the Court may direct

Unless the Court directs

That such punishments shall run concurrently.

## SENTENCE ANALYSIS OF SUB-SECTION (1) OF SECTION 35

MODIFIERS IN SECTION: Noun, Verb, Prepositional, Infinitive and Participle phrases

CLAUSES IN SECTION: There are ten clauses

1. When a person is convicted at one trial of two or more offences  
*(Subordinate clause)*
2. The Court may, subject to the provisions of section 71 of the [Penal Code](#) , sentence him, for such offences, to the several punishments  
*(Independent clause)*
3. Which are prescribed therefor *(Subordinate clause)*
4. Which such Court is competent *(Subordinate clause)*
5. To inflict such punishments *(Subordinate infinitive clause)*
6. When consisting of imprisonment or transportation *(Subordinate clause)*
7. To commence the one after the expiration of the other in such order  
*(Subordinate infinitive clause)*
8. As the Court may direct *(Subordinate clause)*
9. Unless the Court directs *(Subordinate clause)*
10. That such punishments shall run concurrently *(Subordinate clause)*

**CLASSIFICATION OF SENTENCE:** It is a complex-sentence with one independent clause and nine subordinate clauses.
