

EXAMPLE OF ANALYSIS

PAKISTAN PENAL CODE, 1860

3. Punishment of offences committed beyond, but which by law may be tried within Pakistan:

Any person liable, by any Pakistan Law, to be tried for an offence committed beyond Pakistan shall be dealt with according to the provision of this Code for any act committed beyond Pakistan in the same manner as if such act had been committed within Pakistan.

RE-WRITING OF SECTION 3 WITH FINITE VERBS

Whoever is liable, by any Pakistan law,

He shall be tried for an offence

Which is committed beyond Pakistan

He shall be dealt with according to the provision of this Code for any act

Which is committed beyond Pakistan in the same manner

As if such act had been committed within Pakistan.

ANALYSIS OF SENTENCE OF SECTION 3

MODIFIERS IN SECTION: Noun, verb and Prepositional phrases

CLAUSES IN SECTION: There are six clauses

1. Whoever is liable, by any Pakistan law (*Subordinate clause*)
2. He shall be tried for an offence (*Independent clause*)

3. Which is committed beyond Pakistan (*Subordinate clause*)
4. He shall be dealt with according to the provision of this Code for any act (*Independent clause*)
5. Which is committed beyond Pakistan in the same manner (*Subordinate clause*)
6. As if such act had been committed within Pakistan (*Subordinate clause*)

CLASSIFICATION OF SENTENCE: It is a compound- complex- sentence with two independent clauses and four subordinate clauses.
